Hamfest Hours & Setup Times .

Exhibit set-up will be from 5:00pm until 7:00pm Friday afternoon. The doors will be locked at 7:00pm Friday, to be reopened at 7:00 am Saturday morning for continued dealer and exhibitor set-up. The Hamfest will be open to the public at 8:00 am until main prize drawing. Forums will start at 8:00am.

Dealers and exhibitors will have special identifying badges. Only persons wearing these special badges may enter the hamfest building at the designated set-up times. Pre-Hamfest sales are discouraged by MARC and the rules of facility.

Pre-registration ticket and name tag pickup will take place in the main hallway entrance to the hamfest gymnasium, starting at 5:00 pm on Friday, March 15th, and lasting until 7:00 pm. Registrations "at the door" will also be available at these times if available. On Saturday morning pre-registration ticket and name tag pickup as well as new registrations will continue at the gymnasium entrance at 8:00 am.

All Table positions will be pre-assigned. All tables are rented on a first-come, first-served basis to registered Hamfest participants only and must have a rental tag displayed. No refunds for no-shows. Limited A/C outlets, specify in advance or bring a long extension cord if you need power.

All unclaimed tables become available for 1/2 price at 10:00am Saturday.

Worked All States Award Subject to time available

If you have QSL cards confirming contacts from all 50 states (District of Columbia counts as MD), bring your cards and proof of current ARRL membership to apply for the Worked All States Award. The basic award fee is \$12 for each WAS certificate, or \$15 for each WAS certificate and pin, and the endorsement fee is \$7.50. (Endorsements claimed with the initial award are included in the \$12 fee).

If you have confirmed contacts from at least 100 different grid squares, bring your cards and proof of current ARRL membership to apply for the VHF/UHF Century Club Award. The basic award fee is \$17 (certificate) and \$7 (pin). Application fee for ARRL members \$5, for non-members \$10.

If you intend to apply for either of these awards at the Hamfest, or if you have any questions, please contact either ARRL awards manager in advance for changes in fee schedules. We will be available from 8am 'til Noon.
