Your bi-weekly dose of “ARRL The Doctor is In” audio podcast is as close as your computer, tablet or smartphone. Here's how to listen in . . .


If You Have a Desktop or Laptop Computer



If You Have an Apple iPhone or iPad

First, download the free Apple Podcasts app (circled in red below) using the App Store app.



Second, open the Podcast app and find the search function (circled in red below). Search for **ARRL**. You will soon see **ARRL The Doctor is In** listed in the “Suggestions” box. Tap on that line.



Finally, when you see the ARRL Doctor is In icon, double tap on the icon and either download and play an episode, or subscribe and you'll receive each new episode the moment it is released. Subscribing is completely free of charge!

If You Have an Android Phone or Tablet

Go to Stitcher at <http://www.stitcher.com/download>. Move your mouse cursor over the Android symbol and download the free Android Stitcher Radio app. Once the app is installed, use it to search Stitcher for ARRL The Doctor is In. You can subscribe for free and receive every episode.
