## Report of the ARRL Legal Defense and Assistance Committee

## ARRL Board Meeting, July, 2022

It has been a relatively quiet period of time for our committee since the January Board meeting. No requests were received for assistance, financial or otherwise, in any antenna regulation matters.

In February, Jefferson County (Idaho) officials contacted ARRL HQ for input on a local antenna ordinance that was being considered. The ARLDAC reviewed the draft ordinance and made some suggestions regarding areas of possible improvement. The information was conveyed to the Idaho officials by W9JJ.

In June, the committee was asked to review and suggest any comments or edits to a proposed statute for the State of Delaware. It deals with amateur radio antennas and HOAs. The committee reviewed the statute but no specific edits or changes were suggested. Since this arose in the Atlantic Division, Vice Director Famiglio has used his experience in dealing with antenna regulation issues to advise the local Delaware amateurs in their efforts.
